Arthur Thomas "Tom" Galloway, 78 of Hoopeston, Illinois passed away at 2:42 P.M. on Friday, May 11, 2012 at Carle Foundation Hospital, Urbana, IL. He was born March, 15, 1934 in Hoopeston, IL. He was the son of J.W. and Evalena McBeath Galloway. He married Sally Edwards on October 6, 1956. She survives in Hoopeston.
