



Rebecca Jean Klotzbach

Rebecca Jean (Marshall) Klotzbach, 68, of Rossville, IL, passed away at 4:15 A.M. Monday April 16, 2018 at Carle Foundation Hospital in Urbana, IL. She was born May 27, 1949, in Paxton, IL the daughter of Wayne and Mary (Randish) Marshall. She married David Klotzbach on June 25, 1971 at the Methodist Chapel in Rantoul, IL. He survives in Rossville, IL.

She was a member of the Grace Lutheran Church in Rankin, where she served as a lay person and the secretary for the Grace Lutheran Church Council.

Rebecca was active in organizing and distributing food pantry supplies, made hats for chemo patients, hats and mittens for school age children, and made burial garments for the Preemie Project. She was an organ donor and two-gallon blood donor. She was an avid knitter and taught others to knit. Rebecca also loved baking, attending musicals, and spent countless hours maintaining burial plots of family and friends at Rankin Cemetery. Per her wishes, she will be cremated.
